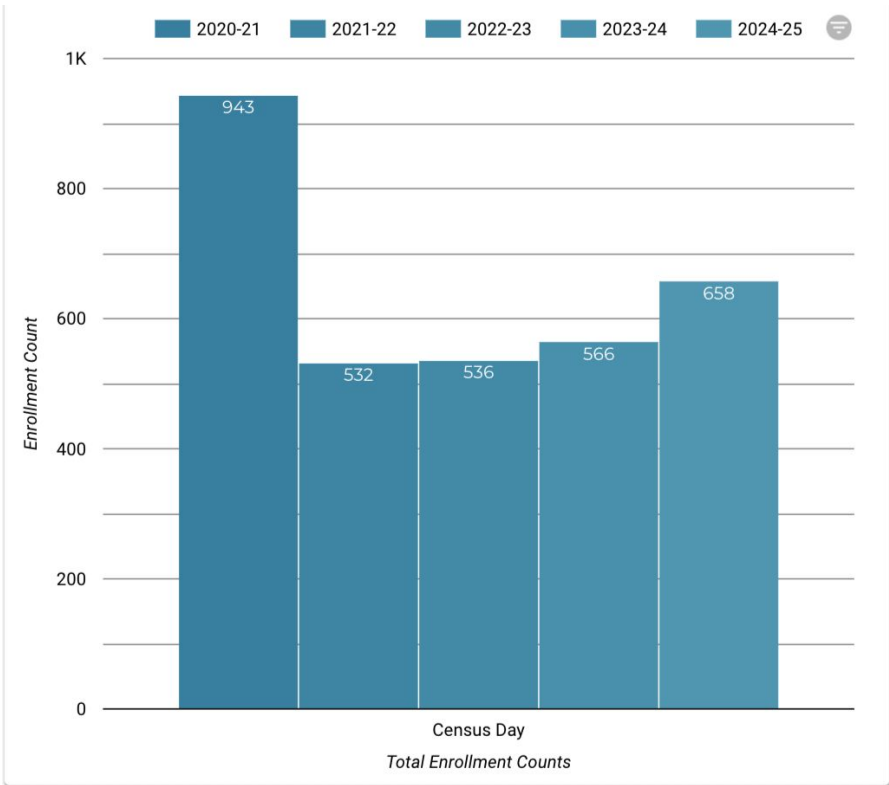

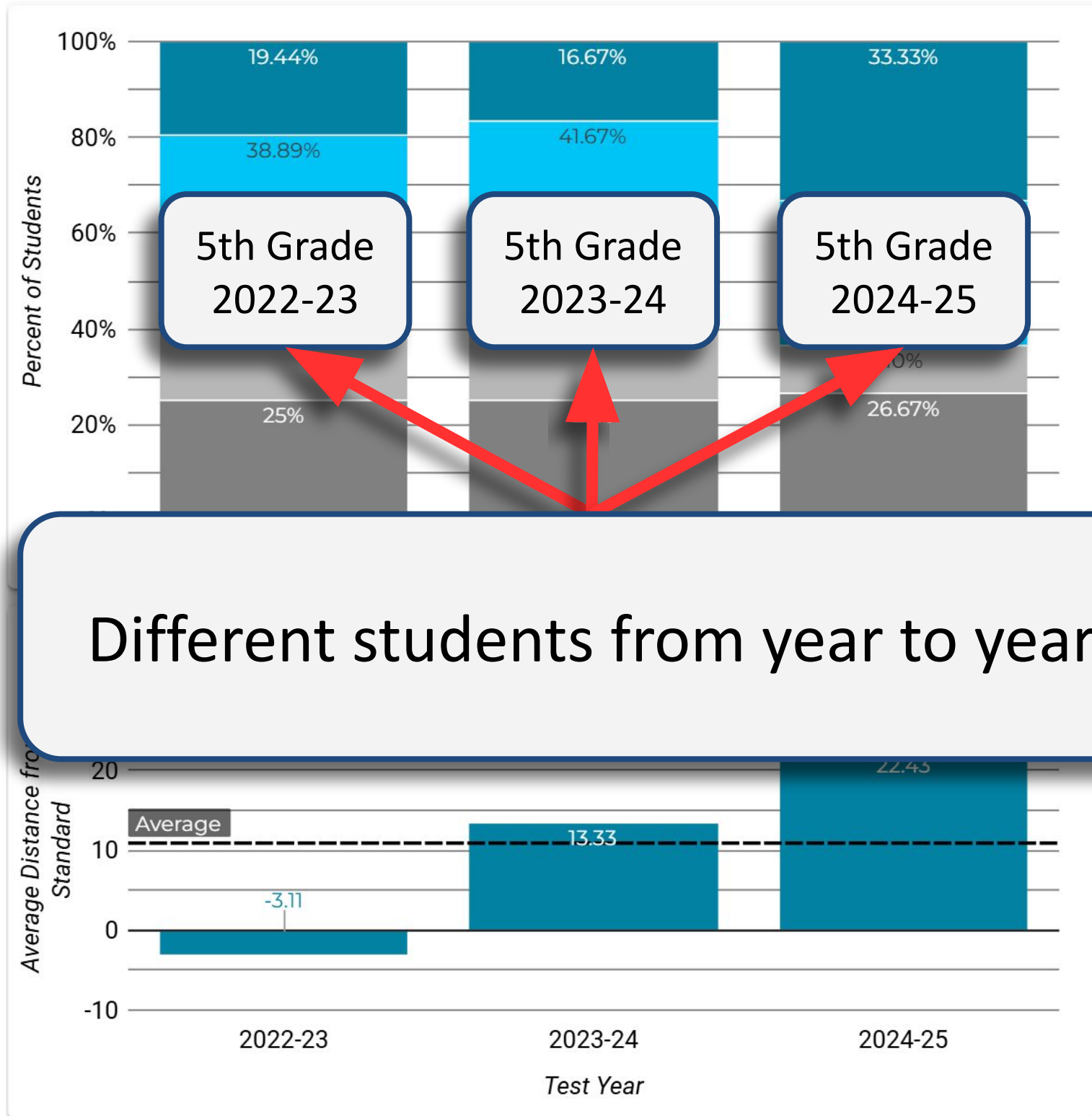

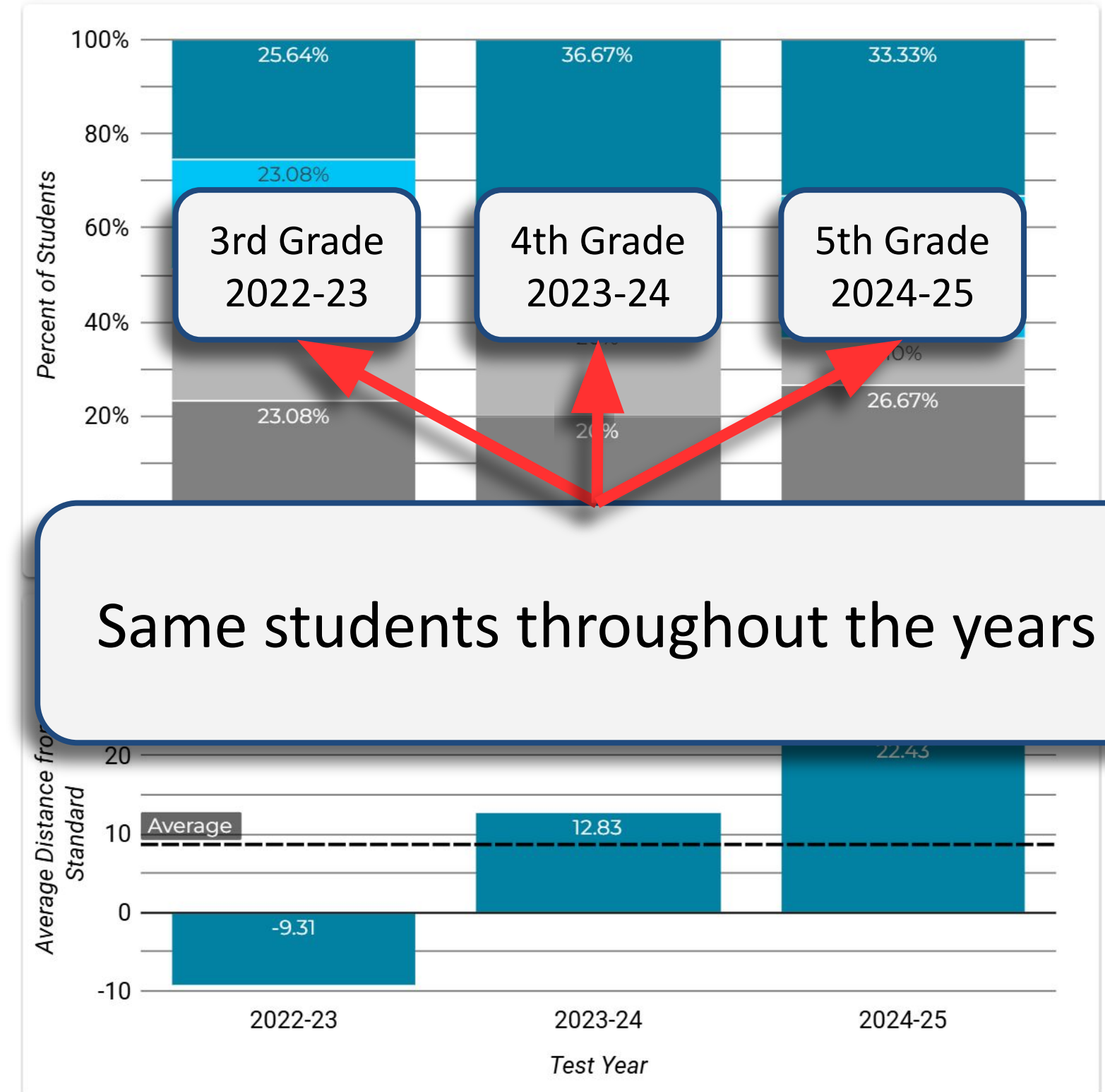

CAASPP Scale Score Bands



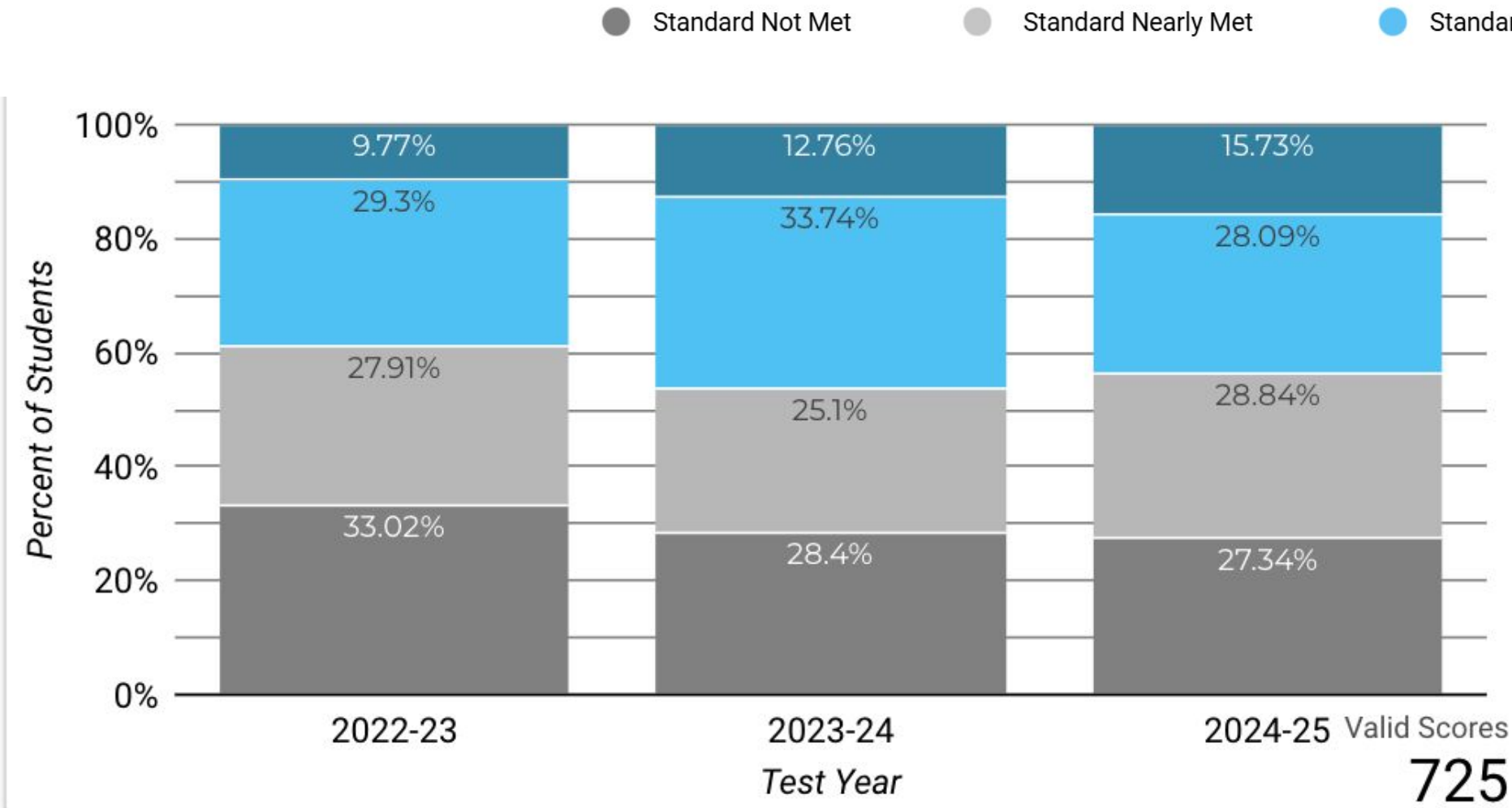
Maintaining the same performance level requires **different amounts of growth** depending on the grade level transition.

For example, “Met” jumps +49 in Math from 3rd to 4th grade but only +15 from 6th to 7th grade.

iReady Explained



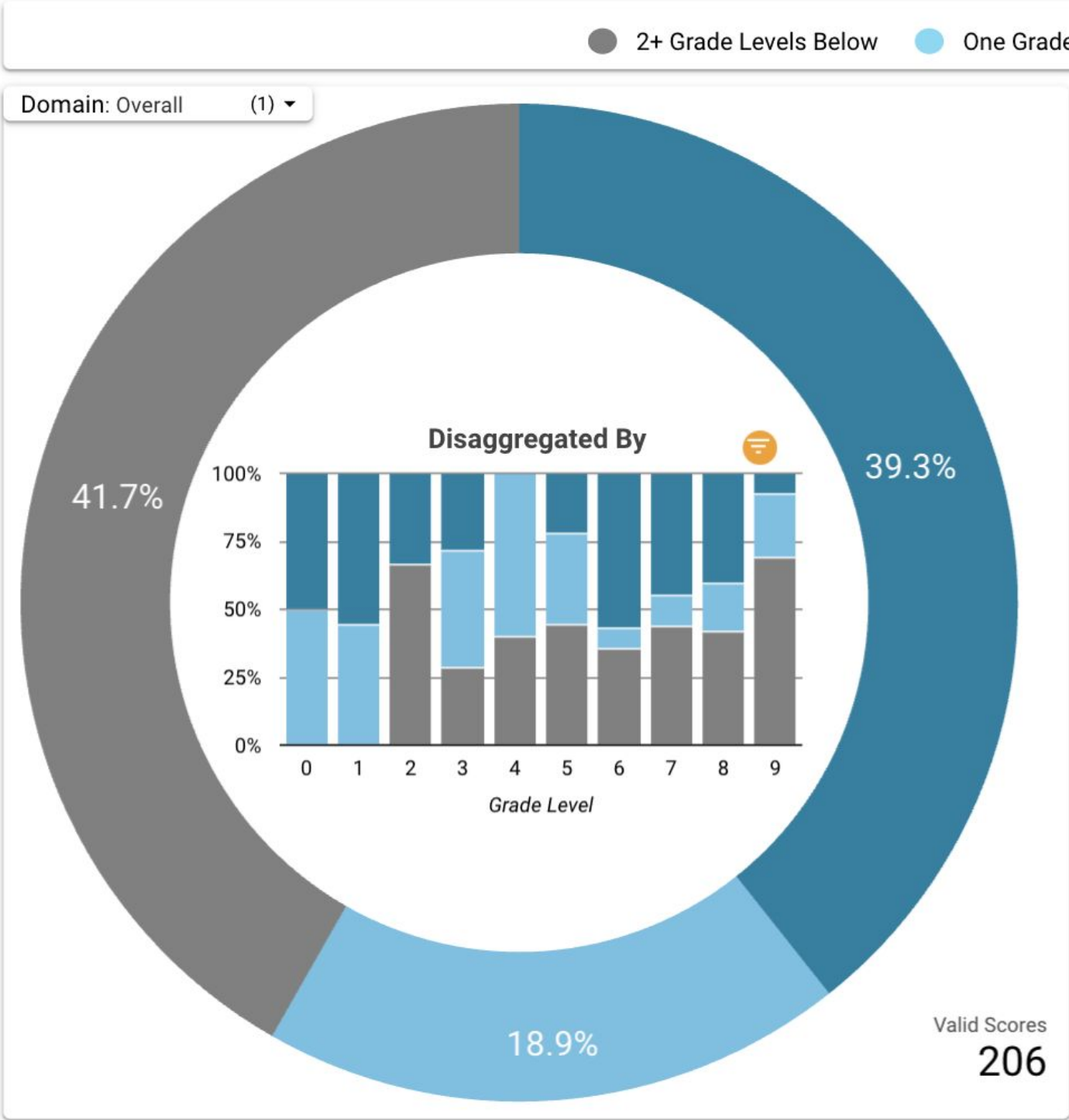
iReady measures how well students are progressing toward **grade-level standards**.

This means iReady is considered a **“criterion-referenced” assessment**.

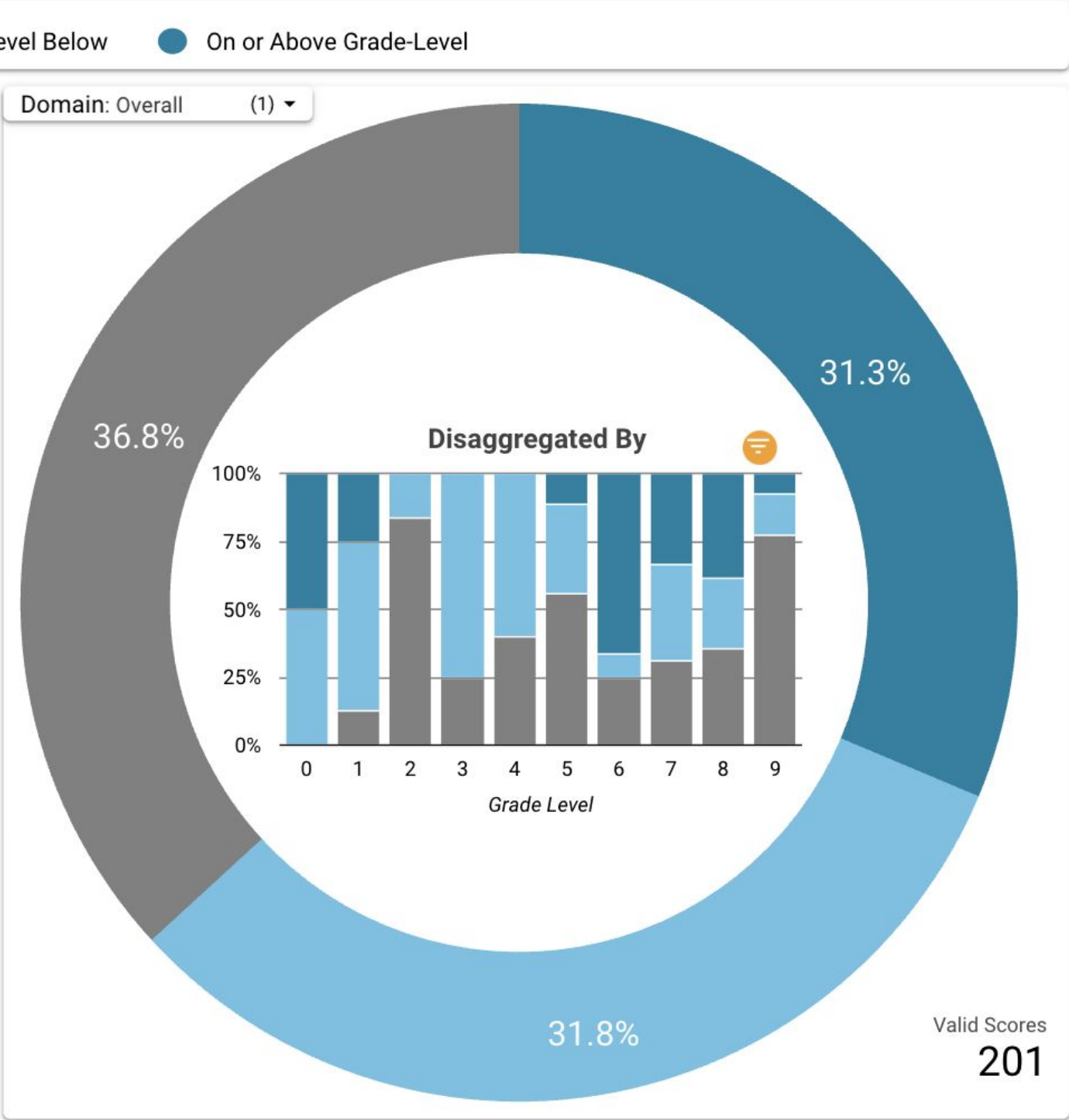

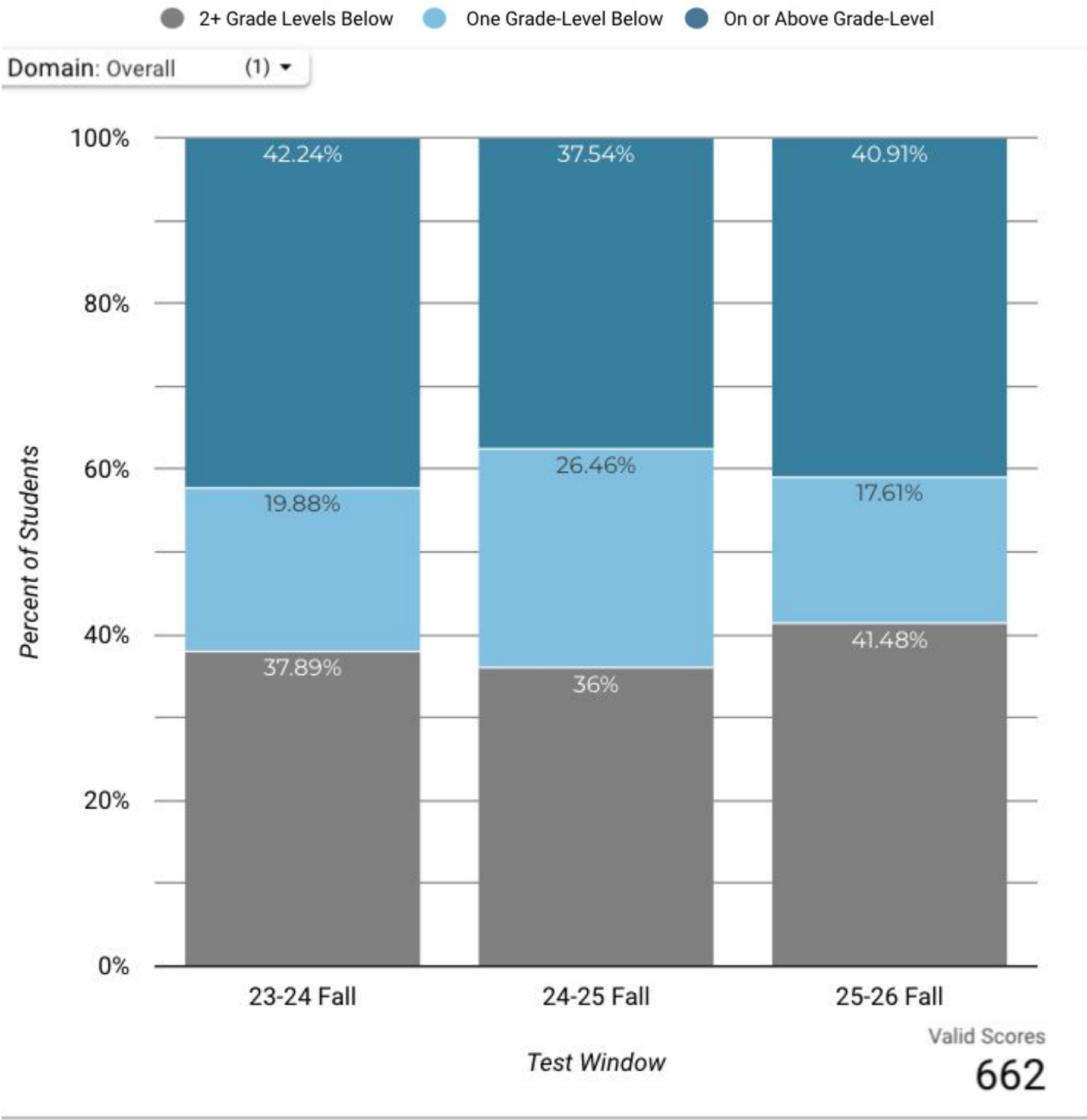

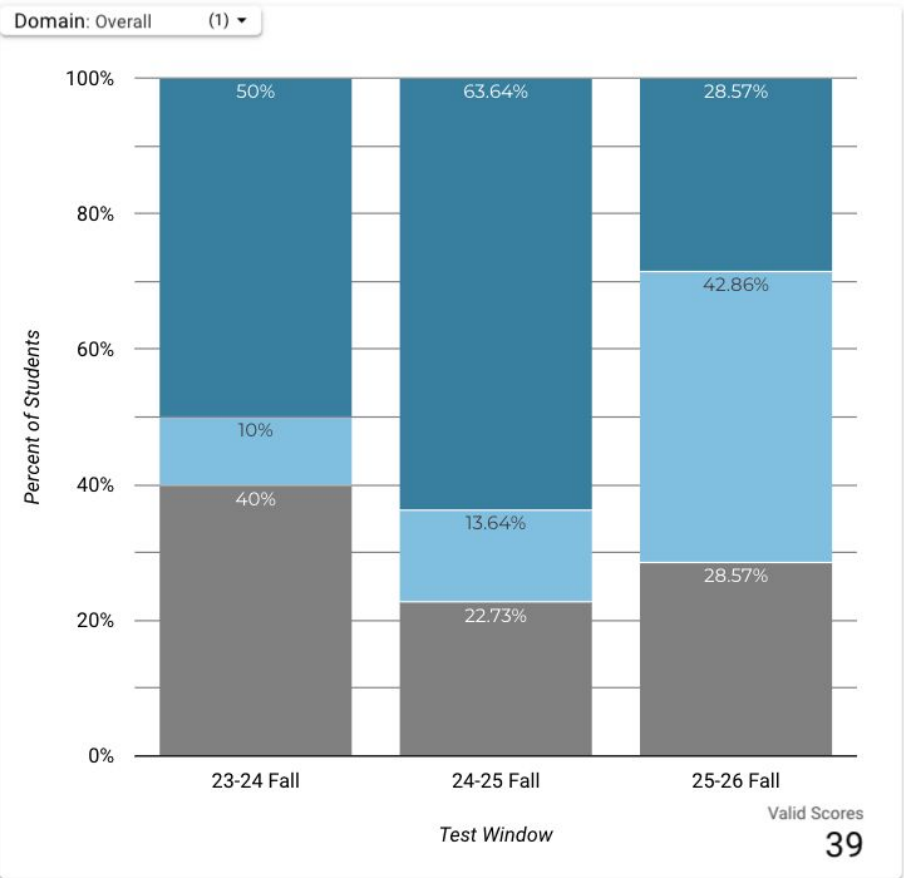

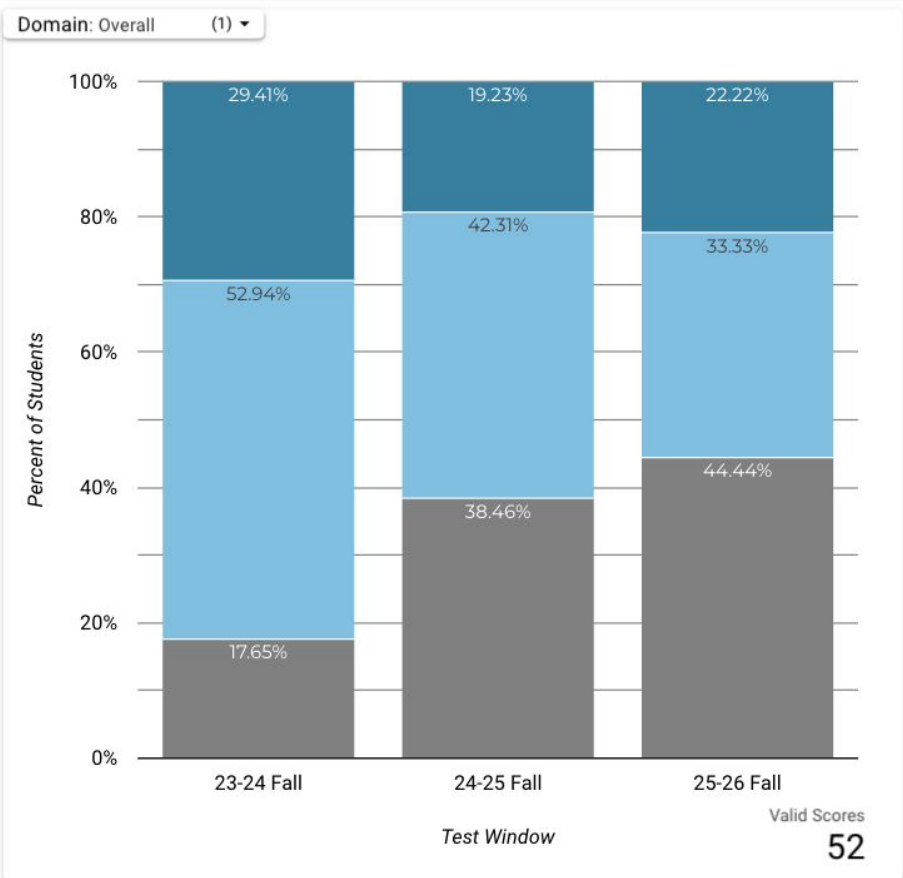

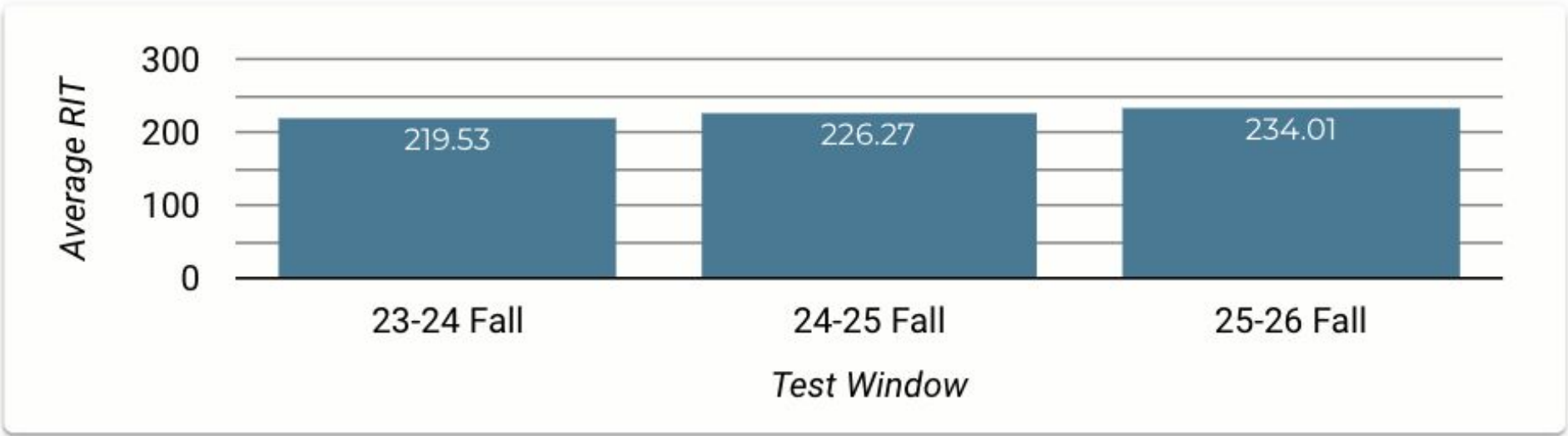
